Two prior approvals via requisition required



Request or Requisition can be used for prior approvals

GA@WURK / New Processes

Requisition does not have budgetary impact



Requisitions will commit funds

Buyer can create a PO reflecting another person's card



On PO, the buyer and cardholder must match

The cardholder requests approval for a p-card transaction and verifies the transaction during the reconciliation process.

**Business Process** 

**Procurement Card Transaction Verification** – this business process is a GA@WORK Financials function that is integrated to reconcile a procurement card transaction and indicate that it is eligible for payment (settlement).

Roles

**Cardholder** – business process initiator

**Employee** – business process initiator

**Approvers** – manager, cost center manager
