SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Enrolled as a full- or part-time student within the **Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG)**.
- Pursuing a degree/certification in accounting, banking and finance, or business administration.
- Earning a cumulative and major grade point average of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale.
- Intention to pursue a career in the public sector, preferably the State of Georgia.
- Availability to attend one Georgia Fiscal Management Council meeting of your choice during the 2026-2027 enrollment year. (GFMC meetings occur once per month.)

APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Completed application package **MUST** be received by **May 29, 2026**, including:

1. Completed Student Application Form.
2. Completed Departmental Chair Endorsement Form.
3. One written professional reference.
4. Written description of career goals, including why you desire to pursue a public sector career related to Fiscal Management or Administration within the State of Georgia.
5. Official college transcript sent by the TCSG college directly to the Scholarship Committee Chair listed below.
